hereby Adopted

by the Board of Selectmen

of the Town of Shelburne

Special Speed Regulation No. 1000 dated January 9, 1975 is hereby amended in Shelburne as follows:

That the following speed limit are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

COLRAIN SHELBURNE ROAD-NORTHBOUND

By striking out the clause reading
0.65 miles at 30 miles per hour ending at the Colrain
Town Line; the total distance being 2.26 miles.

And inserting in place thereof

0.14 miles at 30 miles per hour

0.51 " " 35 " " ending at the Colrain Town Line. the total distance being 2.26 miles.

COLRAIN SHELBURNE ROAD-SOUTHBOUND

By striking out the clause reading 0.65 miles at 30 miles per hour

And inserting in place thereof

0.51 miles at 35 miles per hour

0.14 " " 30 " " "

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
