Name of Highway: COLRAIN SHELBURNE ROAD

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Shelburne

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

COLRAIN SHELBURNE ROAD-NORTHBOUND

Beginning 150 feet north of Route 2
Thence northerly on Colrain Shelburne Road
0.39 miles at 30 miles per hour
1.22 " " 35 " " "
0.65 " " 30 " " " ending at the Colrain
Town Line; the total distance being 2.26 miles.

SHELBURNE COLRAIN ROAD-SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the Colrain Town Line
Thence southerly on Shelburne Colrain Road
0.65 miles at 30 miles per hour
1.22 " " 35 " " "
0.42 " " 30 " " " ending at Route 2;
the total distance being 2.29 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
