WALSH ROAD MIDDLESEX TURNPIKE

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Bedford

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

ASHBY ROAD-NORTHBOUND

Beginning at Walsh Road
Thence northerly on Ashby Road
0.19 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at the Great Road; the total distance being 0.19 miles

ASHBY ROAD-SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the Great Road
Thence southerly on Ashby Road
0.19 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at Walsh Road; the total distance being 0.19 miles.

WALSH ROAD-NORTHBOUND

Beginning at a point 300 feet north of Ashby Road
Thence northerly on Walsh Road
0.16 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at the Great Road; the total distance being 0.16 miles.

WALSH ROAD-SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the Great Road
Thence southerly on Walsh Road
0.16 miles at 25 miles per hour
0.06 " " 20 " " " ending at Ashby Road; the total distance being 0.22 miles.

CROSBY DRIVE-NORTHBOUND

Beginning at a point 250 feet north of Crosby Road
Thence northerly on Crosby Drive
0.55 miles at 40 miles per hour
0.29 " " 30 " " " ending at Middlesex
Turnpike; the total distance being 0.84 miles.

CROSBY DRIVE-SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at Middlesex Turnpike
Thence southerly on Crosby Drive
0.29 miles at 30 miles per hour
0.55 " " 40 " " "
0.05 " " 20 " " " ending at Crosby
Road; the total distance being 0.89 miles.

MIDDLESEX TURNPIKE-NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the Burlington Town line
Thence northerly on Middlesex Turnpike
0.58 miles at 40 miles per hour
1.04 " " 45 " " " ending at the
Billerica Town line; the total distance being 1.62 miles.

MIDDLESEX TURNPIKE-SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the Billerica Town line
Thence southerly on Middlesex Turnpike
1.04 miles at 45 miles per hour
0.58 " " 40 " " " ending at the
Burlington Town line; the total distance being 1.62 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
