Highway Location: SAUGUS
Authority In Control: TOWN OF SAUGUS
Name of Highway: FAIRMONT AVENUE

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Saugus

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

FAIRMONT AVENUE-NORTHBOUND

Beginning at Sherman Street
Thence northerly on Fairmont Avenue
0.52 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at Walnut Street; the total distance being 0.52 miles.

FAIRMONT AVENUE-SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at Walnut Street
Thence southerly on Fairmont Avenue
0.52 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at Sherman Street; the total distance being 0.52 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
