Highway Location: COHASSET  
Authority In Control: TOWN OF COHASSET  
Name of Highway: FOREST AVENUE

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted  
by the Board of Selectmen  
of the Town of Cohasset

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

FOREST AVENUE-NORTHBOUND

Beginning at North Main Street  
Thence northerly on Forest Avenue  
1.28 miles at 30 miles per hour  
0.11 " " 20 " " " ending at Jerusalem  
Road; the total distance being 1.39 miles.

FOREST AVENUE-SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at Jerusalem Road  
Thence southerly on Forest Avenue  
1.39 miles at 30 miles per hour ending at North  
Main Street; the total distance being 1.39 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
