In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Wilbraham

Special Speed Regulation number 139 dated May 21, 1957 is hereby amended by striking out the regulation in its entirety and inserting in place thereof the following revision and addenda:

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

STONY HILL ROAD - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the Hampden - Wilbraham line

Thence northerly on Stony Hill Road

0.40 miles at 25 miles per hour
2.05 " " 35 " " "
0.42 " " 30 " " "
1.92 " " 35 " " "
0.11 " " 25 " " " ending at Route 20;

the total distance being 4.90 miles.

STONY HILL ROAD - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at Route 20

Thence southerly on Stony Hill Road

2.03 miles at 35 miles per hour ✓
0.42 " " 30 " " " ✓
2.05 " " 35 " " "
0.40 " " 25 " " " ending at the

Wilbraham - Hampden line; the total distance being 4.90 miles.

EAST LONGMEADOW ROAD - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the Springfield - Wilbraham line;
Thence northerly on East Longmeadow Road
0.60 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at
Stony Hill Road; the total distance being 0.60 miles.

EAST LONGMEADOW ROAD - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at Stony Hill Road;
Thence southerly on East Longmeadow Road
0.60 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the
Wilbraham - Springfield line; the total distance being 0.60 miles.

SPRINGFIELD STREET - EASTBOUND

Beginning at the Springfield - Wilbraham line;
Thence easterly on Springfield Street
1.10 miles at 40 miles per hour ✓
0.25 " " 30 " " " ✓
0.32 " " 45 " " " ✓ *Rev to 40 (12/17/26)*
0.70 " " 35 " " " ending at Main
Street; the total distance being 2.37 miles.

SPRINGFIELD STREET - WESTBOUND

Beginning at Main Street
Thence westerly on Springfield Street
0.70 miles at 35 miles per hour
0.32 " " 45 " " " *Rev to 40 (12/17/26)*
0.25 " " 30 " " "
1.10 " " 40 " " " ending at the
Wilbraham - Springfield line; the total distance being 2.37 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
