In accordance with the provisions of Section 18 of Chapter 90 of the Genera Laws (Ter. Ed.), as amended by Section 2 of Chapter 564 of the Acts of 1948, the following Special Speed Regulation is hereby made by the Department of Public Works and the Registrar of Motor Vehicles, acting jointly, and shall be effective immediately upon compliance with the applicable provisions of the above-referenced Section 2.	
The following designated speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:	
	arnstable 145 feet north of the junction of Route 28, 0.13 miles at 40 miles per hour to the Mashpee line.
Thence northerly in Ma	shpee 0.92 miles at 40 miles per hour
thence	0.68 " "45 " " " to the end of State

SOUTHBOUND Beginning in Sandwich at the junction of Route 6A, 0.85 miles at 35 miles per hour thence southerly 64 Mi @ 25 M, P, ff 11 thence 0.50 # # 30 # # 11 25 0.14 11 11 to the end of State highway, north of town way. And beginning in Sandwich at the beginning of State highway, south of town way, thence southerly 0.74 miles at 40 miles per hour thence 1.02 " " 45 " " " to the end of State high-

Beginning again in Mashpee 242 feet from the beginning of State highway, thence southerly 0.70 miles at 45 miles per hour thence 0.92 " " 40 " " " to the Barnstable line.

Thence southerly in Barnstable

0.07 miles at 40 miles per hour thence 0.09 " " 30 " " " ending at the junction of Route 28; the total distance being 5.03 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Section 14 of Chapter 90.

The Department of Public Works and the Registrar of Motor Vehicles, acting jointly, do hereby certify in writing, after a public hearing, that this regulation is consistent with the public interests.

Standard signs must be erected at the beginning of each zone.
