SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 177-A

Highway Location: CONCORD

Name of Highway: BARRETTS MILL ROAD

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Concord

Special Speed Regulation number 177 dated December 16, 1958 is hereby amended by striking out all clauses pertaining to Barretts Mill Road and inserting in place thereof the following revision.

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

BARRETTS MILL ROAD - NORTHEASTBOUND

Beginning at the Traffic Circle on Route 2
Thence northeasterly on Barretts Mill Road
0.06 miles at 25 miles per hour
0.30 " " 30 " " "
0.34 " " 20 " " "
1.15 " " 30 " " " ending at Lowell Road;
the total distance being 1.85 miles.

BARRETTS MILL ROAD - SOUTHWESTBOUND

Beginning at Lowell Road
Thence southwesterly on Barretts Mill Road
1.15 miles at 30 miles per hour
0.34 " " 20 " " "
0.30 " " 30 " " "
0.06 " " 25 " " " ending at the Traffic
Circle on Route 2; the total distance being 1.85 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
