SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 2003

Highway Location: HINSDALE
Authority In Control: TOWN OF HINSDALE
Name of Highway: MIDDLEFIELD ROAD

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Hinsdale

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

MIDDLEFIELD ROAD-EASTBOUND

Beginning 250 feet east of the junction of Route 8
Thence easterly on Middlefield Road.

0.33 miles at 40 miles per hour
0.54 " " 35 " " "
0.32 " " 25 " " "
0.14 " " 20 " " "
0.56 " " 30 " " " ending at the Peru
Town Line; the total distance being 1.89 miles.

MIDDLEFIELD ROAD-WESTBOUND

Beginning at the Peru-Hinsdale Town Line
Thence westerly on Middlefield Road.

0.56 miles at 30 miles per hour
0.14 " " 20 " " "
0.32 " " 25 " " "
0.54 " " 35 " " "
0.33 " " 40 " " "
0.05 " " 25 " " " ending at the junction
of Route 8; the total distance being 1.94 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
