Name of Highway: MIDDLETON ROAD

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Boxford

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

MIDDLETON ROAD-NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the junction of Endicott Road
Thence northerly 0.37 miles at 25 miles per hour
0.68 " " 35 " " "
1.03 " " 40 " " "
0.33 " " 30 " " "
0.10 " " 20 " " "
0.52 " " 30 " " "
0.30 " " 25 " " "
0.20 " " 30 " " " ending at Georgetown
Road and Elm Street; the total distance being 3.53 miles.

MIDDLETON ROAD-SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at a point 450 feet south of Georgetown Road and
Elm Street
Thence southerly 0.11 miles at 30 miles per hour
0.30 " " 25 " " "
0.52 " " 30 " " "
0.10 " " 20 " " "
0.33 " " 30 " " "
1.03 " " 40 " " "
0.68 " " 35 " " "
0.37 " " 25 " " " ending at the junction
of Endicott Road; the total distance being 3.44 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
