Name of Highway: ROUTE 8A (West Hawley Rd. & North Heath Rd.)

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Charlemont

Special Speed Regulation No. 2010 dated April 22, 1976 is hereby amended in Charlemont as follows:

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described.

ROUTE 8A, (WEST HAWLEY ROAD & NORTH HEATH ROAD-NORTHBOUND

By striking out the clause reading
0.34 miles at 35 miles per hour

And inserting in place thereof
0.34 miles at 25 miles per hour

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of the limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
