Authority In Control: TOWN OF EASTHAM
Name of Highway: Three Acres Road

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18 of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Eastham

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

Three Acres Road - EASTBOUND

Beginning at the beginning of Three Acres Road,
Thence easterly
0.16 miles at 20 miles per hour ending at Route 6,
the total distance being 0.16 miles.

Three Acres Road - WESTBOUND

Beginning at Route 6,
Thence westerly on Three Acres Road,
0.16 miles at 20 miles per hour ending at the end
of Three Acres Road, the total distance being 0.16 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14 of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
