In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) us amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted

by the Board of Selectmen

of the Town of North Andover

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

## MASSACHUSETTS AVENUE - EASTBOUND

Beginning at the end of State Highway, Thence easterly 1.62 miles at 35 miles per hour, ending at the junction of Great Pond Road and Johnson Street.

# MASSACHUSETTS AVENUE - WESTBOUND

Beginning at the junction of Johnson Street and Great Fond Road. Thence westerly 1.62 miles at 35 miles per hour, ending at the beginning of State Highway.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
