SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 2091

Highway Location: Cambridge
Authority in Control: Director, Traffic & Parking Department
Name of Highway(s): Huron Avenue

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Director of Traffic & Parking
of the City of Cambridge

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

Huron Avenue - Eastbound

Beginning at Grove Street, thence easterly on Huron Avenue

1.84 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at Raymond Street, the total distance being 1.84 miles.

Huron Avenue - Westbound

Beginning at Raymond Street, thence westerly on Huron Avenue

1.84 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at Grove Street, the total distance being 1.84 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
