Special Speed Regulation numbered 213-A dated July 24, 1975 is hereby amended as follows:

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

ROUTE 110-NORTHBOUND

By striking out the clauses reading 0.24 miles at 30 miles per hour 1.22 " " 40 " " "

And inserting in place thereof
0.35 miles at 30 miles per hour
1.11 " " 40 " " "

ROUTE 110-SOUTHBOUND

By striking out the clauses reading 1.22 miles at 40 miles per hour 0.24 " " 30 " " "

And inserting in place thereof
1.11 miles at 40 miles per hour
0.35 " " 30 " " "

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
