SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION No. 252-B

Highway Location: AGAWAM
Authority In Control: MASSACHUSETTS HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT
Name of Highway(s): ROUTE 57 – STATE HIGHWAY - AGAWAM

In accordance with the provisions of MASS. GEN. LAWS Ch. 90, § 18 (2006), the following Special Speed Regulation is hereby promulgated:

Special Speed Regulations numbered 252 and 252-A, dated June 4, 1963 and March 10, 1964, respectively, are hereby amended by striking out the Regulations in their entireties and inserting in place the following revisions and addenda:

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

ROUTE 57 AGAWAM - EASTBOUND

Beginning at Sta. 140+00, 1,768 feet east of the beginning of state highway,
Thence easterly on Route 57 in Agawam
4.34 miles at 55 miles per hour
0.33 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the junction of Route 5 south (Sta. 179+22); the total distance being 4.67 miles.

ROUTE 57 AGAWAM - WESTBOUND

Beginning 63 feet west of Sta. 169+13 (Jct. Agawam Rotary), Thence westerly on Route 57 in Agawam
0.18 miles at 35 miles per hour
4.21 miles at 55 miles per hour
0.43 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the end of state highway (Jct. Route 187); the total distance being 4.82 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense MASS. GEN. LAWS ch. 90, § 14 (2006).

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


Standard signs must be erected at the beginning of each zone.
