SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 259-C

Highway Location: WEBSTER

In accordance with the provisions of Section 18 Chapter 90 of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) the following Special Speed Regulation is hereby promulgated:

Special Speed Regulation number 259-B dated October 20, 1983 is hereby amended by striking out the Regulation in its entirety and inserting in place thereof the following revision.

The following designated speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described.

NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the beginning of State highway at the Connecticut State Line.

Thence northerly

0.35 miles at 40 miles per hour

1.21 " " 35 " " "

0.20 " " 30 " " " ending at the end of

State Highway; the total distance being 1.76 miles.

SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the beginning of State Highway

Thence southerly

0.20 miles at 30 miles per hour

1.21 " " 35 " " "

0.35 " " 40 " " " ending at the Connecticut

State Line; the total distance being 1,76 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense, Section 14 of Chapter 90.

The Department of Public Works and the Registrar of Motor Vehicles, acting jointly do hereby certify in writing, that this regulation is consistent with the public interest.

Standard signs must be erected at the beginning of each zone.
