In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Amherst

Special Speed Regulation number 278 dated September 23, 1964 is hereby amended by striking out all clauses pertaining to East Pleasant Street and inserting in place thereof the following revision and addenda.

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

EAST PLEASANT STREET-NORTHBOUND

Beginning at North Pleasant Street
Thence northerly on East Pleasant Street
0.46 miles at 30 miles per hour
0.37 " " 35 " " "
1.32 " " 40 " " "
0.20 " " 35 " " " ending at Pine Street;
the total distance being 2.35 miles.

EAST PLEASANT STREET-SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at Pine Street
Thence southerly on East Pleasant Street
0.20 miles at 35 miles per hour
1.32 " " 40 " " "
0.37 " " 35 " " "
0.46 " " 30 " " " ending at North Pleasant
Street; the total distance being 2.35 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
