Highway Location: MARSHFIELD

Authority in Control: TOWN OF MARSHFIELD

Name of Highway: Webster Street

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted

by the Board of Selectmen

of the Town of Marshfield

Special Speed Regulation Number 302 dated September 29, 1965 is hereby amended on Webster Street as follows:

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

Webster Street - EASTBOUND

By striking out the clauses reading:

0.47	miles	at	35	miles	per	hour
0.50	"	"	40	"	"	"
0.51	"	"	35	"	"	"
0.63	"	"	40	"	"	"

And inserting in place thereof:

2.11 miles at 35 miles per hour.

Webster Street - WESTBOUND

By striking out the clauses reading:

0.63	miles	at	40	miles	per	hour
0.51	"	"	35	"	"	"
0.50	"	"	40	"	"	"
0.47	"	"	35	"	"	"

And inserting in place thereof:

2.11 miles at 35 miles per hour.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
