In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

Hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Raynham

Special Speed Regulation number 3031, dated February 1, 1977 is hereby amended on Route 104 (North Main Street) as follows:

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

ROUTE 104 - (NORTH MAIN STREET) - NORTHBOUND

By striking out the clause reading
0.10 miles at 25 miles per hour.

ROUTE 104 - (NORTH MAIN STREET) - SOUTHBOUND

By striking out the clause reading
0.10 miles at 25 miles per hour.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
