In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is -

hereby Adopted

by the Board of Selectmen

of the Town of Andover

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

LOVEJOY ROAD NORTHBOUND

Beginning at DASCOMB ROAD thence northerly
0.12 miles at 30 miles per hour
thence 1.28 miles at 35 miles per hour

ending at LOWELL STREET (Route 133). The total distance being 1.40 miles.

LOVEJOY ROAD SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at LOWELL STREET (Route 133) thencesoutherly 1.28 miles at 35 miles per hour

thence 0.12 miles at 30 miles per hou

ending at DASCOMB ROAD. The total distance being 1.40 miles.

CENTRAL STREET NORTHBOUND

Beginning at a point 190 feet north of ANDOVER STREET, thence northerly 0.30 miles at 25 miles per hour

thence 0.30 miles at 25 miles per hour 0.32 miles at 35 miles per hour

0.28 miles at 30 miles per hour

ending at ESSEX STREET. The total distance being 0.90 miles.

CENTRAL STREET SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at ESSEX STREET, thence southerly

0.28 miles at 30 miles per hour

0.32 miles at 35 miles per hour

0.28 miles at 25 miles per hour

0.06 miles at 20 miles per hour

ending at ANDOVER STREET. The total distance being 0.94 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
