Highway Location: LENOX  
Authority in Control: TOWN OF LENOX  
Name of Highway: Holmes Road

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted  
by the Board of Selectmen  
of the Town of Lenox

Special Speed Regulation Number 336 dated April 4, 1966 is hereby amended by striking out all clauses relating to Holmes Road and inserting in place thereof the following revision and addenda.

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described.

Holmes Road - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the end of State Highway,

Thence northerly on Holmes Road  
0.47 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the Pittsfield City line; the total distance being 0.47 miles.

Holmes Road - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the Pittsfield City line,

Thence southerly on Holmes Road  
0.47 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the beginning of State Highway; the total distance being 0.47 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
