SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 365-A

Highway Location: BELLINGHAM  
Authority In Control: TOWN OF BELLINGHAM  
Name of Highway: ROUTE 126

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted  
by the Board of Selectmen  
of the Town of Bellingham

Special Speed Regulation number 365 dated October 24, 1966 is hereby amended by striking out all clauses pertaining to Route 126 and inserting in place thereof the following revision and addenda

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

ROUTE 126-NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the end of State Highway  
Thence northerly on Route 126  
0.25 miles at 25 miles per hour  
0.25 " " 40 " " "  
3.95 " " 45 " " "  
0.21 " " 40 " " "  
0.09 " " 25 " " " ending South of Route  
140.

And beginning again 460 feet north of Route 140  
Thence northerly on Route 126  
0.15 miles at 35 miles per hour  
1.55 " " 45 " " "  
0.27 " " 25 " " " ending at the beginning  
of State Highway

And beginning again at the end of State Highway  
Thence northerly on Route 126  
0.35 miles at 40 miles per hour  
0.74 " " 35 " " "  
0.58 " " 40 " " " ending at the Medway  
Town line, the total distance being 8.39 miles.

ROUTE 126-SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the Medway Town line  
 Thence southerly on Route 126  
 0.58 miles at 40 miles per hour  
 0.74 " " 35 " " "  
 0.35 " " 40 " " " ending at the beginning  
 of State Highway

And beginning again at the end of State Highway  
 Thence southerly on Route 126  
 0.27 miles at 25 miles per hour  
 1.55 " " 45 " " "  
 0.15 " " 35 " " "  
 0.09 " " 25 " " " ending at Route 140

And beginning again South of Route 140  
 Thence southerly on Route 126  
 0.30 miles at 40 miles per hour  
 3.95 " " 45 " " "  
 0.25 " " 40 " " "  
 0.25 " " 25 " " " ending at the beginning  
 of State Highway, the total distance being 8.48 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
