SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION 37-A

Highway Location: TOWN OF ESSEX
Authority in Control: TOWN OF ESSEX
Name of Highway: Martin St., Western Ave., and Southern Ave.

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Essex

Special Speed Regulation number 37, dated August 21, 1951 is hereby amended by striking out the Regulation in its entirety and inserting in place thereof the following revision and addenda.

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

MARTIN STREET-EASTBOUND

Beginning at Western Avenue
Thence easterly on Martin Street
0.54 miles at 35 miles per hour
0.20 " " 25 " " " ending at Main Street, the total distance being 0.74 miles.

MARTIN STREET-WESTBOUND

Beginning at Main Street
Thence westerly on Martin Street
0.20 miles at 25 miles per hour
0.49 " " 35 " " "
0.05 " " 25 " " " ending at Western Avenue, the total distance being 0.74 miles.

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SOUTHERN AVENUE-NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the Manchester Town line,
Thence northerly on Southern Avenue,

0.66 miles at 45 miles per hour
0.87 " " 40 " " "
0.61 " " 35 " " "
0.27 " " 30 " " "

ending at Main Street,
the total distance being 2.41 miles.

SOUTHERN AVENUE-SOUTHBOUND

Beginning 50 feet south of Main Street,
Thence southerly on Southern Avenue

0.27 miles at 30 miles per hour
0.61 " " 35 " " "
0.87 " " 40 " " "
0.66 " " 45 " " "

ending at the Manchester
Town line, the total distance being 2.41 miles.

WESTERN AVENUE-EASTBOUND

Beginning at the Hamilton Town line,
Thence easterly on Western Avenue,

1.36 miles at 40 miles per hour
0.89 " " 35 " " "

ending at Main Street,
the total distance being 2.25 miles.

WESTERN AVENUE-WESTBOUND

Beginning at Main Street, thence westerly on Western Avenue,

0.89 miles at 35 miles per hour
1.36 " " 40 " " "

ending at Hamilton Town
line, the total distance being 2.25 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of
these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater
than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate
in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
