SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 380-B

Highway Location: MANCHESTER
Authority In Control: TOWN OF MANCHESTER
Name of Highway: PINE STREET

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Manchester

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

Special Speed Regulation Number 380, dated July 20, 1967, is hereby amended by striking out all clauses pertaining to Pine Street and inserting the following:

PINE STREET-NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the junction of Central Street,
Thence northerly 0.56 miles at 35 miles per hour
0.12 " " 25 " " "
0.64 " " 35 " " " ending at the beginning
of State Highway; the total distance being 1.32 miles.

PINE STREET-SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the end of State Highway,
Thence southerly 0.64 miles at 35 miles per hour
0.12 " " 25 " " "
0.49 " " 35 " " "
0.07 " " 25 " " " ending at the junction
of Central Street; the total distance being 1.32 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter.Ed).
