SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION # 380-D

Highway Location: MANCHESTER-BY-THE-SEA

Name of Highway (s): PLEASANT STREET, LINCOLN STREET

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

Hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Manchester-by-the-Sea

Special Speed Regulation Number 380, dated July 20, 1967 is hereby amended by striking out all clauses pertaining to Pleasant Street and Lincoln Street and inserting in place thereof the following revisions and addenda:

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

PLEASANT STREET - EASTBOUND

Beginning at the junction of Pine Street, thence easterly on Pleasant Street

0.55 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at the junction of School Street; the total distance being 0.55 miles.

PLEASANT STREET - WESTBOUND

Beginning at the junction of School Street, thence westerly on Pleasant Street

0.55 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at the junction of Pine Street; the total distance being 0.55 miles.

LINCOLN STREET - EASTBOUND

Beginning at the junction of School Street, thence easterly on Lincoln Street

0.49 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at the junction of Summer Street (Route 127); the total distance being 0.49 miles.

LINCOLN STREET - WESTBOUND

Beginning at the junction of Summer Street (Route 127), thence westerly on Lincoln Street

0.34 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at the junction of Arbella Street; the total distance being 0.34 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
