In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted

by the Board of Selectmen

of the Town of Amherst

Special Speed Regulation No. 392 dated December 20, 1967 is hereby amended as follows:

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

BAY ROAD-EASTBOUND

And beginning again at a point 160 feet east of Route 116 Thence easterly on Bay Road

By Striking out the clauses reading: 0.74 miles at 40 miles per hour 2.37 " " 45 " " "

And inserting in place thereof:
3.11 miles at 40 miles per hour

BAY ROAD-WESTBOUND

Beginning at the Belchertown-Amherst-Town Line Thence westerly on Amherst

By striking out the clauses reading: 2.46 miles at 45 miles per hour 0.67 " " 40 " " "

And inserting in place thereof:
3.13 miles at 40 miles per hour

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper. The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
