Highway Location: ROCKLAND
Authority in Control: TOWN OF ROCKLAND
Names of Highways: Beech & Spring Streets

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18 of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Rockland

Special Speed Regulation number 402 dated February 19, 1968 is hereby amended as follows:

By striking out all clauses pertaining to Beech & Spring Streets and inserting in place thereof:

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the area described.

NORTHBOUND - BEECH & SPRING STREETS

Beginning at the Hanson Town line
Thence northerly
0.36 miles at 45 miles per hour
0.25 " " 35 " " "
0.17 " " 30 " " "
1.68 " " 35 " " "
0.08 " " 25 " " " ending at Route 123; the
total distance being 2.54 miles.

SOUTHBOUND - SPRING & BEECH STREETS

Beginning at a point 100 feet south of Route 123
Thence southerly
1.74 miles at 35 miles per hour
0.17 " " 30 ✓ " " "
0.25 " " 35 ✓ " " "
0.36 " " 45 " " " ending at the Hanson line;
the total distance being 2.52 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
