Name of Highway: HAMILTON STREET

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted  
by the Board of Selectmen  
of the Town of Saugus

Special Speed Regulation Number 4024, dated March 24, 1978 is hereby amended by striking out that section pertaining to Hamilton Street and inserting in place thereof the following revision:

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

HAMILTON STREET-WESTBOUND

Beginning at the Lynn-Saugus Line  
Thence westerly 0.63 miles at 35 miles per hour  
0.46 " " 30 " " " " ending at the junction  
of Central Street; the total distance being 1.09 miles.

HAMILTON STREET-EASTBOUND

Beginning at the junction of Central Street  
Thence easterly 0.46 miles at 30 miles per hour  
0.63 " " 35 " " " " ending at the Saugus-  
Lynn Line; the total distance being 1.09 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.)
