SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION No. 407A

Name of Highway: Saville Street

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Saugus

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

SAVILLE STREET - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at Hamilton Street, thence northerly on Saville Street, 0.70 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at Central Street, the total distance being 0.70 miles.

SAVILLE STREET - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at Central Street, thence southerly on Saville Street 0.70 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at Hamilton Street, the total distance being 0.70 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
