Highway Location: ROCKLAND

Name of Highway: North Avenue

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Rockland

Special Speed Regulation Number 408 dated May 28, 1968 is hereby amended on North Avenue as follows:

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

NORTH AVENUE - EASTBOUND

By striking out the clauses reading:
0.89 miles at 35 miles per hour
0.09 " " 25 " " "

And inserting in place thereof
0.81 miles at 35 miles per hour
0.17 " " 25 " " "

NORTH AVENUE - WESTBOUND

By striking out all clauses

And inserting in place thereof:

Beginning 350 feet west of Union Street

Thence westerly on North Avenue

0.91 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the Abington town line; the total distance being 0.91 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.)
