Highway Location: FLORIDA
Authority In Control: TOWN OF FLORIDA
Name of Highway: CENTRAL SHAFT ROAD, SOUTH STREET,
TILDA HILL ROAD & NORTH COUNTY ROAD.

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Florida

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicle may be operated in the areas described:

CENTRAL SHAFT ROAD-NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the Savoy-Florida Town Line
Thence northerly on Central Shaft Road
1.73 miles at 30 miles per hour
0.14 " " 20 " " "
0.65 " " 35 " " "
0.84 " " 40 " " "
0.54 " " 30 " " " ending at Route 2; the
total distance being 3.90 miles.

CENTRAL SHAFT ROAD-SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at Route 2
Thence southerly on Central Shaft Road
0.54 miles at 30 miles per hour
0.84 " " 40 " " "
0.65 " " 35 " " "
0.14 " " 20 " " "
1.73 " " 30 " " " ending at Savoy-Florida
Town Line; the total distance being 3.90 miles.

SOUTH STREET-NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the end of South Street
Thence northerly on South Street
0.85 miles at 30 miles per hour ending at South County Road;
the total distance being 0.85 miles.

SOUTH STREET-SOUTHBOUND

Date of Present 10-2-77

Beginning at South County Road
Thence southerly on South Street
0.85 miles at 30 miles per hour ending at the end of South Street; the total distance being 0.85 miles.

TILDA HILL ROAD-NORTHBOUND

Beginning at Route 2
Thence northerly on Tilda Hill Road
2.20 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the Monroe-Florida Town Line; the total distance being 2.20 miles.

TILDA HILL ROAD-SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the Monroe-Florida Town Line
Thence southerly on Tilda Hill Road
2.20 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at Route 2; the total distance being 2.20 miles.

NORTH COUNTY ROAD-EASTBOUND

Beginning at the West end of Route 2
Thence easterly on North County Road
0.29 miles at 30 miles per hour
0.50 " " 25 " " " ending at the East end of Route 2; the total distance being 0.79 miles.

NORTH COUNTY ROAD-WESTBOUND

Beginning at the East end of Route 2
Thence westerly on Route 2
0.50 miles at 25 miles per hour
0.29 " " 30 " " " ending at the West end of Route 2; the total distance being 0.79 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
