SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 411-C

Highway Location: BELLINGHAM AND MENDON

In accordance with the provisions of Section 18 Chapter 90 of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) the following Special Speed Regulation is hereby promulgated:

Special Speed Regulation number 411-B dated May 22, 1974 is hereby amended in Bellingham and Mendon as follows:

The following designated speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described.

NORTHBOUND - BELLINGHAM

By striking out the clauses reading
0.58 miles at 40 miles per hour
0.62 " " 45 " " " to the Mendon line.

and inserting in place thereof
1.20 miles at 40 miles per hour to the Mendon line.

NORTHBOUND - MENDON

By striking out the clauses reading
0.85 miles at 45 miles per hour
0.19 " " 40 " " " to the Hopedale line

and inserting in place thereof
1.04 miles at 40 miles per hour to the Hopedale line.

SOUTHBOUND - MENDON

By striking out the clauses reading
0.19 miles at 40 miles per hour
0.85 " at 45 " " " to the Bellingham line

and inserting in place thereof
1.04 miles at 40 miles per hour to the Bellingham line.

SOUTHBOUND - BELLINGHAM

By striking out the clauses reading
0.62 miles at 45 miles per hour
0.58 " " 40 " " "

and inserting in place thereof
1.20 miles at 40 miles per hour.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense, Section 14 of Chapter 90.


The Department of Public Works and the Registrar of Motor Vehicles, acting jointly do hereby certify in writing, that this regulation is consistent with the public interest.
