SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 424

Highway Location: TOWN OF RANDOLPH  
Authority In Control: TOWN OF RANDOLPH  
Name of Highway: Liberty Street

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted  
by the Board of Selectmen  
of the Town of Randolph

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

Liberty Street - EASTBOUND

Beginning 100 feet east of North Main Street,  
Thence easterly on Liberty Street  
0.46 miles at 35 miles per hour  
0.21 " " 30 " " " ending at North Street,  
the total distance being 0.67 miles.

Liberty Street - WESTBOUND

Beginning 100 feet west of North Street,  
Thence westerly on Liberty Street  
0.19 miles at 30 miles per hour  
0.48 " " 35 " " " ending at North Main  
Street, the total distance being 0.67 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
