SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 427

Highway Location: TOWN OF COLRAIN
Authority In Control: TOWN OF COLRAIN
Name of Highway: MAIN ROAD - Route 112

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Colrain

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

Main Road - (Route 112) - Northbound

Beginning at the end of State Highway Station 100+03,
thence northerly on Main Road - Route 112
0.35 miles at 30 miles per hour
ending at the beginning of State Highway Station 118+50, the total distance being 0.35 miles.

Main Road - (Route 112) - Southbound

Beginning at the end of State Highway Station 118+50,
thence southerly on Main Road - Route 112
0.35 miles at 30 miles per hour
ending at the beginning of State Highway Station 100+03, the total distance being 0.35 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
