SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 458

Highway Location: SHEFFIELD
Authority in Control: TOWN OF SHEFFIELD
Name of Highway: Berkshire School Road

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Sheffield

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described.

BERKSHIRE SCHOOL ROAD - EASTBOUND

Beginning at Route 41,
thence easterly on Berkshire School Road,
0.52 miles at 40 miles per hour
1.36 " " 35 " " "
0.65 " " 40 " " "
0.26 " " 30 " " " ending at Route 7,
the total distance being 2.79 miles.

BERKSHIRE SCHOOL ROAD - WESTBOUND

Beginning 100 feet west of Route 7,
thence westerly on Berkshire School Road,
0.24 miles at 30 miles per hour
0.65 " " 40 " " "
1.36 " " 35 " " "
0.52 " " 40 " " " ending at Route 41,
the total distance being 2.77 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.)
