SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION # 471-D

Highway Location: STURBRIDGE - HOLLAND

Name of Highway (s): Interstate Route 84

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is hereby promulgated:

Special Speed Regulation number 471-B dated December 7, 1971 is hereby amended by striking out the regulation in its entirety and inserting in place thereof the following revision and addenda.

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

EASTBOUND

Beginning 750 feet north of the Connecticut State Line, thence easterly on Route I-84;

5.41 miles at 65 miles per hour

0.76 miles at 55 miles per hour ending at Station 333+25, the total distance being 6.17 miles.

WESTBOUND

Beginning at Station 330+00, thence easterly on Route I-84, 6.16 miles at 65 miles per hour to the Holland Town Line.

Thence southerly in Holland,

0.10 miles at 65 miles per hour ending at the Connecticut State Line, the total distance being 6.26 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).

The Highway Department and the Registry of Motor Vehicles, acting jointly, do hereby certify that this regulation is consistent with the public interest.

Standard signs must be erected at the beginning of each zone.
