Authority In Control: TOWN OF DENNIS
Name of Highway: Route 134

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Dennis

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

NORTHBOUND - Route 134

Beginning 150 feet north of Route 28,
Thence northerly on Route 134

1.16 miles at 45 miles per hour	OK
0.78 " " 35 " " "	OK
0.37 " " 40 " " "	OK
2.09 " " 45 " " "	mis 40
0.85 " " 40 " " "	
0.06 " " 30 " " "	ending at Route 6A,

the total distance being 5.31 miles.

SOUTHBOUND - Route 134

Beginning 150 feet south of Route 6A,
Thence southerly on Route 134,

0.88 miles at 40 miles per hour	
2.09 " " 45 " " "	
0.37 " " 40 " " "	
0.78 " " 35 " " "	
1.04 " " 45 " " "	
0.15 " " 30 " " "	ending at Route 28,

the total distance being 5.31 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
