hereby Adopted

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

HOLLISTON STREET - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at Village Street, Thence northerly on Holliston Street

0.87 miles at 35 miles per hour

town line, the total distance being 2.85 miles.

HOLLISTON STREET - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the Holliston town line, Thence southerly on Holliston Street.

1.77 miles at 35 miles per hour

0.87 " 35 " " " ending at Village Street, the total distance being 2.85 miles.

WINTHROP STREET - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at Main Street (Route 109) Thence northerly on Winthrop Street,

0.34 miles at 30 miles per hour

1.91 " " 40 " " ending at the Holliston town line, the total distance being 2.25 miles.

WINTHROP STREET - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the Holliston town line,
Thence southerly on Winthrop Street,

1.91 miles at 40 miles per hour

0.34 " " 30 " " " ending at Main Street (Route 109), the total distance being 2.25 miles.

SUMMER STREET - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at Main Street,

Thence northerly on Summer Street

0.48 miles at 40 miles per hour

0.22 " " 30 " "

0.25 " " 40 " " "

1.73 " " 45 " " ending at the Holliston

town line, the total distance being 2.68 miles.

SUMMER STREET - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the Holliston town line, Thence southerly on Summer Street,

1.73 miles at 45 miles per hour

0.25 " " 40 " " "

0.22 " " 30 " " "

0.38 " " 40 " " "

0.10 " " 25 " " ending at Main Street,

the total distance being 2.68 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
