Name of Highway: EAST STREET

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Middleton

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

EAST STREET-NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the junction of Maple Street, (Route 62)
Thence northerly 1.99 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at
the junction of the Middleton-Boxford Town Line.

EAST STREET-SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the junction of the Middleton-Boxford Town Line
Thence southerly 1.89 miles at 35 miles per hour
0.10 " " 25 " " " ending at the
junction of Maple Street, (Route 62); the total distance being 1.99 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
