SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 5030

Highway Location: BRIDGEWATER  
Authority In Control: TOWN OF BRIDGEWATER  
Name of Highway: ROUTE 28

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted  
by the Board of Selectmen  
of the Town of Bridgewater

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

ROUTE 28 - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at a point 350 feet north of Central Square  
Thence northerly on Route 28  
1.19 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the  
beginning of State Highway at the West Bridgewater Town Line; the  
total distance being 1.19 miles.

ROUTE 28 - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the end of State Highway at the West Bridgewater  
Town Line,  
Thence southerly on Route 28  
1.19 miles at 35 miles per hour  
0.07 " " 25 " " " ending at Central  
Square; the total distance being 1.26 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
