 Name of Highway: BAY ROAD

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
 by the Board of Selectmen
 of the Town of Stoughton

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

BAY ROAD-SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at Easton Town Line
 Thence southerly on Bay Road

0.11 miles at 35 miles per hour	
0.24 " " 25 " " "	
0.42 " " 30 " " "	
0.17 " " 25 " " "	
0.40 " " 30 " " "	
1.02 " " 35 " " "	ending at Plain Street;

the total distance being 2.36 miles.

BAY ROAD-NORTHBOUND

Beginning at Plain Street
 Thence northerly on Bay Road

1.02 miles at 35 miles per hour	
0.40 " " 30 " " "	
0.17 " " 25 " " "	
0.42 " " 30 " " "	
0.24 " " 25 " " "	
0.11 " " 35 " " "	ending at Easton Town

Line; the total distance being 2.36 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
