hereby Adopted

by the Board of Selectmen

of the Town of Berkley

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

## BAY VIEW AVENUE-SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at Elm Street

Thence southerly on Bay View Avenue.

1.14 miles at 35 miles per hour

2.65 " " 25 " " ending at Riverside Drive; the total distance being 3.79 miles.

# BAY VIEW AVENUE-NORTHBOUND

Beginning at Riverside Drive Thence northerly on Bay View Avenue.

2.65 miles at 25 miles per hour 1.08

." " 35 0.06 11

25 " ending at Elm Street; the total distance being 3.79 miles.

### JEROME STREET-EASTBOUND

Beginning at the Taunton City Line Thence easterly on Jerome Street

0.15 miles at 30 miles per hour 0.19 25

0.10 30 0.92

0.53 " ending at the end of Jerome 30 Street; the total distance being 1.89 miles.

#### JEROME STREET-WESTBOUND

Beginning at the beginning of Jerome Street
Thence westerly on Jerome Street

0.53 miles at 30 miles per hour 0.92 " " 35 " " "

0.15 " " 30 " " ending at the Taunton

City Line; the total distance being 1.89 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14 of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
