That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

## SOUTH STENCER ROAD - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the East Brookfield Town line Thence northerly on South Spencer Road

0.39 miles at 35 miles per hour 25 0.19 11 11 1.75 30 11 11 11 0.35 20 11 11 \*\* 0.86

0.05 ending at Route 9; the total

distance being 3.59 miles.

## SOUTH STENCER ROAD - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at a point 150 feet south of Route 9 Thence southerly on South Spencer Road

0.88 miles at 35 miles per hour 0.35 20 11 11 11 11 1.75 30 11 0.19 25

0.39 35 ending at the East Brookfield Town line; the total distance being 3.56 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
