Name of Highway: South Spencer Road

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18 of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Spencer

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

SOUTH SPENCER ROAD - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the East Brookfield Town line
Thence northerly on South Spencer Road
0.39 miles at 35 miles per hour
0.19 " " 25 " " "
1.75 " " 30 " " "
0.35 " " 20 " " "
0.86 " " 35 " " "
0.05 " " 25 " " " ending at Route 9; the total
distance being 3.59 miles.

SOUTH SPENCER ROAD - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at a point 150 feet south of Route 9
Thence southerly on South Spencer Road
0.88 miles at 35 miles per hour
0.35 " " 20 " " "
1.75 " " 30 " " "
0.19 " " 25 " " "
0.39 " " 35 " " " ending at the East Brookfield
Town line; the total distance being 3.56 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
