In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Rockport

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

Railroad Avenue - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at Main Street,
thence northerly on Railroad Avenue
0.25 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at Summit
Avenue and King Street; the total distance being 0.25 miles.

Railroad Avenue - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at Summit Avenue and King Street,
thence southerly on Railroad Avenue
0.25 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at Main Street;
the total distance being 0.25 miles.

Granite Street - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at Summitt Avenue and King Street,
thence northerly on Granite Street
0.38 miles at 25 miles per hour
0.10 " " 15 " " "
0.28 " " 25 " " "
0.20 " " 30 " " "
0.53 " " 20 " " "
1.08 " " 25 " " " ending at Gloucester
City line; the total distance being 2.57 miles.

Granite Street - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the Gloucester City line,
thence southerly on Granite Street

1.08 miles at 25 miles per hour

0.53 " " 20 " " "

0.20 " " 30 " " "

0.28 " " 25 " " "

0.10 " " 15 " " "

0.38 " " 25 " " " ending at Summit

Avenue and King Street; the total distance being 2.57 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.)
