SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 589

Highway Location: ASHLAND-SOUTHBOROUGH

Authority in Control: COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS
DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

Name of Highway: Cordaville Road & Southville Road
(Misc. State Highway)

In accordance with the provisions of Section 18 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) the following Special Speed Regulation is hereby promulgated:

The following designated speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described.

Cordaville Road & Southville Road - WESTBOUND

Beginning in Ashland at the beginning of State Highway,
thence westerly

0.52 miles at 35 miles per hour

0.20 " " 25 " " "

0.75 " " 35 " " " to the Southborough line,

Thence westerly in Southborough

0.65 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the end
of State Highway; the total distance being 2.12 miles.

Southville Road & Cordaville Road - EASTBOUND

Beginning in Southborough at the beginning of State Highway,
thence easterly

0.65 miles at 35 miles per hour to the Ashland line,

Thence easterly in Ashland

0.75 miles at 35 miles per hour

0.20 " " 25 " " "

0.52 " " 35 " " " ending at the end of
State Highway; the total distance being 2.12 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense, Section 14 of Chapter 90.

The Department of Public Works and the Registrar of Motor Vehicles, acting jointly do hereby certify in writing, that this regulation is consistent with the public interest.

Standard signs must be erected at the beginning of each zone.
