SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 597

Highway Location: WILLIAMSTOWN
Authority in Control: Town of Williamstown
Name of Highway: North Street

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby adopted

by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Williamstown.

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

NORTH STREET - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at a point 100 feet north of the junction of Main Street (Route 2)
Thence northerly on North Street
0.24 miles at 30 miles per hour, ending at the beginning of State Highway.

NORTH STREET - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the end of State Highway,
Thence southerly on North Street
0.26 miles at 30 miles per hour, ending at the junction of Main Street (Route 2)

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
