In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the City Council
of the City of Leominster

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

ROUTE 117 - EASTBOUND

Beginning at a point 200 feet east of Route 12
Thence easterly on Route 117
0.36 miles at 25 miles per hour
0.60 " " 30 " " "
0.84 " " 35 " " "
1.07 " " 45 " " " ending at the beginning
of State Highway; the total distance being 2.87 miles.

ROUTE 117 - WESTBOUND

Beginning at the end of State Highway
Thence westerly on Route 117
1.07 miles at 45 miles per hour
0.84 " " 35 " " "
0.60 " " 30 " " "
0.40 " " 25 " " " ending at Route 12;
the total distance being 2.91 miles.

MECHANIC STREET - EASTBOUND

Beginning at Route 12
Thence easterly on Mechanic Street
0.70 miles at 25 miles per hour
0.36 " " 30 " " " ending at the beginning
of State Highway

And beginning again at the end of State Highway
Thence easterly on Mechanic Street
0.31 miles at 30 miles per hour
0.46 " " 35 " " "
0.66 " " 40 " " " ending at the Lancaster
Town Line; the total distance being 2.49 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
