Name of Highway(s): Liberty Street, Eastwater Street
& Plain Street (Route 139)

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18,
of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special
Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Rockland

That the following speed limits are established at which motor
vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

Liberty Street - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at Market Street,
thence northerly on Liberty Street

0.46 miles at 35 miles per hour
0.09 " " 20 " " "
0.32 " " 30 " " "
0.39 " " 35 " " "
0.10 " " 20 " " "
0.31 " " 35 " " "

ending at Liberty Court;

the total distance being 1.67 miles.

Liberty Street - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at Liberty Court,
thence southerly on Liberty Street

0.31 miles at 35 miles per hour
0.10 " " 20 " " "
0.39 " " 35 " " "
0.32 " " 30 " " "
0.09 " " 20 " " "
0.38 " " 35 " " "
0.08 " " 25 " " "

ending at Market Street;

the total distance being 1.67 miles.

Eastwater Street - EASTBOUND

Beginning at Union Street,
thence easterly on Eastwater Street

0.43 miles at 30 miles per hour

0.23 " " 25 " " "

0.23 " " 35 " " "

0.06 " " 25 " " " ending at Webster Street;

the total distance 0.95 miles.

Eastwater Street - WESTBOUND

Beginning at a point 300 feet west of Webster Street,
thence westerly on Eastwater Street

0.23 miles at 35 miles per hour

0.23 " " 25 " " "

0.43 " " 30 " " " ending at Union Street;

the total distance being 0.89 miles.

Plain Street (Route 139) - EASTBOUND

Beginning at North Avenue,
thence easterly on Plain Street (Route 139)

0.64 miles at 35 miles per hour

0.35 " " 30 " " " ending at Market Street;

the total distance being 0.99 miles.

Plain Street (Route 139) - WESTBOUND

Beginning at Market Street,
thence westerly on Plain Street (Route 139)

0.35 miles at 30 miles per hour

0.58 " " 35 " " "

0.06 " " 25 " " " ending at North Avenue;

the total distance being 0.99 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.)
